


Case titled Sukhdev Singh & Anr. Vs Shamas Din

13.09.2023. Case called. Ld. Counsel for the appellants present. None present for respondent. Arguments heard from Ld. Counsel for the appellants. It has been observed that the present appeal has been filed against the order of the Collector dated 22.11.2019 whereby he has set aside mutations Nos. 154 of 31.01.1989 and 52 of 17.01.2001 under Cabinet Order No. 254-C of 1965, 192 of 06.05.2008 of inheritance of S. Jodh Singh and 115 and 116 of 24.09.2004. This court lacks jurisdiction to adjudicate the matter arising out of Evacuees (Admn. of Property) Act Svt. 2006. Since in terms of Rule 17 (1) any person appointed as Deputy Custodian General shall exercise the powers of the Financial Commissioner under Section 15 of the Land Revenue Act, 1996 to revise any order passed by a revenue officer in relation to State lands under these rules and Govt Vide SRO 259 of 1970 dated 04.06.1970 has appointed Divisional Commissioner, Jammu to be a Deputy Custodian General, Jammu for the purpose of exercising such of the powers of the Custodian General as may be delegated to him by or under Section 38 of the Evacuees (Admn. of Property) Act Svt. 2006. In view of the powers being delegated to the Ld. Divisional Commissioner, Jammu, this court is constrained to pass order since the powers delegated to this court are under the Land Revenue Act. As such the case is submitted to the Ld. Divisional Commissioner, Jammu for perusal, please. Parties are directed to appear before Ld. Divisional Commissioner, Jammu on 07.10.2023.
