**IN THE MATTER OF:**

Appeal against the mutation No. 1015/1 dated 11.02.1995 attested in favour of respondents u/s 121 Land Revenue Act with regard to the land passed by Tehsildar Agrarian as Settlement Tehsildar with regard to the land in favour of respondent No. 1 (2 kanals), respondent No. 2 (1 kanal) and respondent No. (4 kanals) situated at Gurah Brahmana, Jammu illegally without jurisdiction and without visiting the spot and in violation of provisions of Land Revenue Act.

**ORDER**

The present appeal came up for hearing today on 15/04/2021. None present from either side. Perusal of order sheet reveals that the appellants have not been attending the court personally or through counsel for quite some time from which it is inferred that the appellants have lost interest to prosecute the case. Therefore, the present case is dismissed in default for non-prosecution on behalf of appellants. The interim order issued by this court, if any, shall stand vacated.
