Revision against the (i) Order dated 30.08.2022 passed by respondent No. 1 i.e. Additional Deputy Commissioner/Collector (with Powers of Commissioner Agrarian Reforms) Rajouri in case titled Mohd Abbas V/s Abdul Manaf whereby he has set aside the mutation no. 1834 of village Chowkian and remanded the case back to Tehsildar for fresh enquiry into all the aspects of the land, purpose (kism), public utility, right of jadi owners, right of people in current possession etc and then to take necessary action as per Land Revenue Act and (ii) order dated 05.09.2022 passed by the respondent no. 2 pursuant to the above said order dated 30.08.2022 by virtue of which the mutation of the petitioner has been cancelled.
Prayer for setting aside the same.

ORDER

This case came up for hearing on 18.04.2024. None present for petitioner and private respondent. ARA appeared on behalf of the official respondents and stated that petitioner is not appearing in the case since long and as such the petition may be dismissed in default for non prosecution on behalf of petitioner. Perusal of order sheet of the case file reveals that neither petitioner/his counsel nor private respondent/ his counsel have been attending the court continuously since 06.12.2023 and today i.e. on 18.04.2024 also they have not caused appearance in the court, from which it is inferred that the petitioner has lost interest to pursue this case and further proceedings in the matter would result in wastage of time of Court. Therefore, the present petition is dismissed in default for non-prosecution on behalf of the petitioner. The interim order issued by this court, if any, shall stand vacated. The case file be consigned to records after due completion but after waiting for the statutory period of 30 days fixed for restoration.
