In the matter of:- Revision petition against the impugned ex-parte order No. DCJ/RDR/2020-21/Panjgarian/02-03 dated 05.09.2016 and order dated 07.09.2020 passed by the respondents by virtue of which mutation No. 458 dated 12.10.2000 passed by respondent no. 2 (Tehsildar AR), Jammu has been set aside on the directions of respondent No. 1. Prayer for setting aside the same.

ORDER

The present petition came up for hearing on 19.10.2023. None present for petitioner. ARA appeared on behalf of respondents. ARA stated that despite providing last opportunity for providing the record, the petitioner have not produced any record to substantiate his claim that he was entitled for vesting of rights in terms of LB-6 of 1958 & S-432 of 1966 and further the order passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Jammu clearly states that as per Jamabandi for the year 1969-70 Khasra No. 899 measuring 64 Kanal 11 Marlas of land was recorded as makbooza sarkar with kind of soil as Gair Mumkin Jad. He requested that the petitioner was not entitled for the conferment of rights under LB-6 and S-432 and the Deputy Commissioner has rightly cancelled the illegal mutation. As such the order passed by Deputy Commissioner does not need any interference. Perusal of the record file reveals that despite providing ample opportunities to the petitioner, the petitioner have not produced any record contradicting the observations recorded in the order of Deputy Commissioner, Jammu. As per the observations made in the order, the land has been recorded as gair mumkin jad in the kind column of Jamabandi for the year 1969-70 and the petitioner have not produced record contrary to the said observation, the petitioner cannot be held to be entitled for vesting of rights in terms of LB-6 & S-432 and accordingly the present petition is dismissed. Interim order issued by this court, if any, shall stand vacated and the case file be consigned to records after due completion. Copy of the order shall go to Deputy Commissioner (District Collector) Jammu and Tehsildar Nagrota for reference and record.
