ORDER

The present revision petition filed against the order No. SDM/Akh/2014-15/1303-05 dated 21.07.2014 passed by the respondent No. 1 wherein the respondent No. 1 has directed the Naib Tehsildar Akhnoor to effect the changes in the land owned and possessed by the petitioners within seven days from the passing of the order came up for hearing today on 20.10.2022. None present for petitioners and private respondent. ARA appeared on behalf of the official respondents and stated that petitioners are not appearing for the last many hearings and as such the petition may be dismissed in default of non prosecution on behalf of petitioners. Perusal of the order sheet reveals that none of the petitioners except petitioner No. 3 was attending the court since the filing of the present revision petition and the only petitioner i.e. petitioner No. 3 who was appearing in the case have recorded his statement on 01.06.2022 for withdrawal of his name from the petitioners which was allowed on 22.09.2022. Since none of the petitioners have appeared thereafter also for the last three hearings in addition to the earlier absence since the filing of the revision petition, this court is constrained to pass order on merits. Therefore, the present petition is dismissed in default of non-prosecution on behalf of petitioners. The interim order issued by this court, if any, shall stand vacated. The case file be consigned to records after due completion but after waiting for the statutory period of 30 days fixed for restoration.
