Application seeking restoration of above titled Revision dismissed in default on 22.09.2022.


ORDER

The present application for restoration of revision petition against the order dated 10.08.2021 passed in file No. 12/DCK/Misc dated 14.08.2017 by the court of Ld. District Collector (Deputy Commissioner), Kishtwar by virtue of which the appeal filed by the petitioner has been dismissed, which was dismissed in default for non prosecution on behalf of petitioner came up for hearing today on 24.05.2023. None present from either side. Perusal of order sheet of the case file reveals that neither petitioner/his counsel nor respondents/ their counsel have been attending the court continuously for last three consecutive hearings and today i.e. on 24.05.2023 also they have not caused appearance in the court, from which it is inferred that the petitioner has lost interest to prosecute his application and further proceedings in the matter would result in wastage of the precious time of Court. In the absence of parties, this court is constrained to return findings on merits. Therefore, the present restoration application is dismissed in default for non-prosecution on behalf of the petitioner. The interim order issued by this court, if any, shall stand vacated. The case file be consigned to records after due completion but after waiting for the statutory period of 30 days fixed for restoration.
