Revision petition against the Order dated 11 Magh 2008 passed on Mutation No. 25 of the Village ChakJawala Singh, Tehsil Vijaypur, District Samba whereby the land comprising under. Khasra Nos. 26 min(154K-16 M), 10 min (13 K-10m), 22 min (20K-08M), 23 min (33K 07 M), 3 min (5K-08m), 7 min (2K), 13 min (2K-05m), 24 min(3K-Q8m) situated at ChakJawala Singh, Tehsil Vijaypur, District Samba, has been wrongly escheated to State under the provisions of the J&K Big Landed Estates Abolition Act, Svt. 2007 with the prayer for setting aside the same and restoring the land in favour of the petitioners.

ORDER

This case came up for hearing on 25/11/2021. Nobody appeared on behalf of petitioners. ARA present for official respondents who stated that the petitioners have not been attending the matter for quite sometime and prayed that the case be dismissed in default for non prosecution. Perusal of order sheet reveals that nobody is appearing on behalf of petitioners for quite some time, from which it is inferred that the petitioners have lost interest to prosecute their case. Further hearings in the matter would yield nothing, but wastage of precious time of the court. From the case file it is observed that no relevant record is available on the case file, which fact is also necessary to be taken in view. Therefore, the case is dismissed in default for non-prosecution on behalf of the petitioners. The case file be consigned to records after due completion but after waiting for the statutory period of 30 days fixed for restoration. The stay granted by this court, if any, shall stand vacated.
