Appeal against the order dated 10.08.2020 (bearing No.ADC/BLR 2020-21/1489 dated 14-08-2020 passed by Additional Deputy Commissioner, Billawar District Kathua in a Complaint case allegedly file by Chanchalo Devi & ors. V/S Vipan Kumar & Ors whereby the Tehsildar Ramkote has been directed/ordered to get demolish/pained illegal stairs from the pathway leading to Ujh river under Section 4 sub section (b) Common land (Regulation Act 1956) constructed by the appellants.

ORDER

26.11.2021.

The case file was presented for hearing and call given to the parties. None appeared on behalf of the appellants. The crux of the case is that-the Appellant filed an appeal against the order dated 10.08.2020 passed by ADC Billawar by virtue of which the Tehsildar Ramkote has been directed to demolish the illegal stairs from the pathway leading to Ujh river under section 4 subsection (b) of common land Regulation Act 1956. The perusal of the file and order sheet, it transpires that the appellants remained absent on many hearings. Beside, neither appellants nor their counsel is appearing in the case which means that the appellants are no more interested to pursue the case. Hence the appeal is dismissed in default, for non prosecution of the case i.e non-appearance of parties. The file be consigned to the record after due completion.
