In the matter of:- Revision Petition against order dated 03.11.2009 passed on mutation No. 6101 under section 8 of Agrarian Reforms Act, 1976 of village.Bagla Tehsil Vijaypur whereby the mutating officer has attested the mutation against the provisions of Standing Order 23-A and prayer for setting aside the same.

ORDER

The instant case came up for hearing on 29.03.2022. None present from either side. Perusal of the order sheet reveals that the petitioners have not been attending the court personally or through their counsel. While examining the case file it has been observed that the mutation which is under challenge before this court falls under the purview of Agrarian Reforms Act 1976 and the same has been attested under section 8 of the said Act. This court lacks jurisdiction to adjudicate upon the matter as the powers of revision under Agrarian Reforms Act are not vested with this Court. Therefore the case is dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. The petitioners are at liberty to challenge the same before the competent forum. The interim order if any issued by this court shall stand vacated. Case file be consigned to records after due completion.
